Letter from the Director

To the Supporters, Community Partners, Donors and Friends of First Step,

As the new Executive Director at First Step, it is my honor and privilege to bring you the 2023 Annual Report. First Step has been a haven of hope, safety and support to survivors of domestic violence in the Seneca, Sandusky, Wood & Wyandot county areas for over 40 years. Since I started serving as Executive Director nine months ago I have had a front row seat to the amazing growth and sustainability First Step has experienced in 2023.

Over the past year, First Step has emerged from a global pandemic even stronger than before. Our financial stability is stronger than ever, and we continue to serve an increasing number of survivors. 2023 has brought numerous physical changes to our shelter from a newly installed playground for children to additional appliances to better serve survivors in shelter. In addition to physical changes, First Step has added three additional full-time employees and two part-time. This enables the shelter to be staffed on a near 24/7 basis providing additional safety and support to survivors.

As First Step moves into the New Year we are looking forward to exploring and implementing new services for our clients. Our dreams for the future include additional space, implementation of the Purple Leash Pet Project, and an upgrade project to our shelter bathrooms and kitchen.

Thank you for joining us in our dream for every individual to live a life free of violence and abuse, where domestic violence is no longer tolerated and everyone is treated with respect and dignity.

Since 1980, First Step has provided shelter for victims of domestic violence and their children, 24-hour support line, advocacy, and outreach and support programs for men, women, and children.



We were the first domestic violence shelter built in the state of Ohio from the ground up 4th in the nation. At First Step, we believe that every individual has the right to live a life free of violence and abuse. 




